Antioch College: This is a liberal arts college that is also a federally recognized work college. Students are required to be a part of a cooperative education work program. At least for the 2015 - 2016, they are also offering full-ride scholarships to admitted first generation college students.

Arizona Assurance (University of Arizona): covers essential college education costs for 8 semesters. Students must be accepted to the program and need a minimum of a 3.0 GPA and to demonstrate financial need (total annual family income of \$42,000 or less on the FAFSA and be eligible for the Federal Pell Grant. Apply by March 1.
