First, an update! On Thursday, Nov 22, ETC and I worked to increase the number of wireless access points available inside FALA. We now have fifteen (15) working access points installed throughout the campus. An access point is the device that connects devices to the internet. When you look at the ceiling in the center of most rooms, you will see a round device that glows blue or green. Blue is 5.0 Ghz, green is 2.4 GHz. We are currently studying usage to determine a pattern that is efficient.

Right now, I am showing 266 wireless clients on-line. These clients are generating 84.2 GB of traffic. Heavy.

Second, remember if you have technology issues, email to helpdesk@flagarts.com.

Third, when we mailed progress reports 3, we included a letter and parent form to complete. The letter talks about a federal technology program called E-Rate. E-rate is a federal program that subsidizes technology, internet connections and related equipment through taxes you already pay on telephones and cellular phone bills. The percentage of FALA's reimbursement will be determined by the percentage of students eligible for Free or Reduced lunches. Ignore that we do not serve lunches, this is how the calculations are generated.

Fourth, is where FALA needs your help. Parents are very busy and may not have returned the "Income Survey for E-Rate Program Calculations." FALA needs as many of the survey forms returned as possible. Today is the day! My first E-Rate meeting is January 11. The return date closes December 14.

Please ask you parents to complete the Income Survey Forms. Please return the Income Survey Forms as soon as possible.
