FALA agrees to set a goal of carbon neutrality by 2030. To achieve these goals, we agree to the following:

Fall 2020

1. Create a sustainability fund on FALA's website for easy tax donations.
2. Maintain an official climate action plan committee including 2 teachers, 2 administrators, and 3-5 students. These individuals will meet monthly during the school year in order to follow up on the Action Plan and create any needed adjustments.
3. Send out a poll to the student body in order to prioritize sustainable solutions.

By Spring 2021

1. Measure and set carbon efficiency goals.
2. Measure and set energy efficiency goals.
3. Measure and set water efficiency goals.
4. Implement a budget plan to purchase energy efficient appliances.
5. Start a budget for experiential learning trips for students.
6. Annual teach-in about the climate crisis, on Earth Day.


By the end of 2021 school year, the following are agreed to:


1. Plastic free events.
2. Installation of eco-friendly light bulbs for when old lightbulbs die.
3. Install motion detector low-flow water faucets in all bathrooms.
4. Climate change unit incorporated in each science curriculum


By the end of 2025 school year, the following are agreed to:

1. Double-pane windows installed.
2. Installing hand dryers in replacement of paper towels.
3. Motion detection water bottle fillers in addition to water fountains already installed.
